Home Study Program

The Home Study Program option provides families who have a child with special needs the opportunity for their child to be instructed at home under the supervision of the Director of Religious Education.

Parents agree to commit to set aside time for home study and to make every effort to complete the program of study as approved by the Director of Religious Education. Depending on the child, this program may include the successful completion of a series of unit tests taken at the Parish Center. Per the requirements of the Diocese of Metuchen, parents may be required by the pastor to be certified as catechists before undertaking the Home Study Program with their child.

Parents are asked to sign a contract to indicate that they understand that home schooling education is to be taken seriously and done diligently. Parents indicate by their signature that they accept responsibility for enabling their child with special needs to undertake their formal religious education at home. Full tuition is charged for the Home Study Program since it is developed and supervised by the Director of Religious Education.

The Home Study Program is not for those who would prefer a different schedule in order for their child to participate in sports programs or other extracurricular activities.
