Poor families can raise and breed pigs to provide a self-sustaining source of income, as well as food to stave off malnutrition.

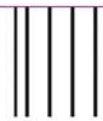

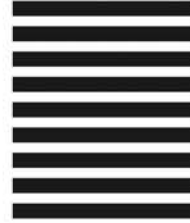


Food For The Poor works with missionaries like **Sister Edna**, in Guatemala, to provide them with the food and nutrition needed to save malnourished little ones.
